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Term 2 Task 2 - Presentation

As a professional artist or designer, the student will need to present their work to the client and publisher. They will need to produce a presentation of the work that has been completed for the project to show how they reached their final designs. The presentation must be 8-10 slides and should include:

- Text, images and design elements that communicate your points such as headers, notes, lines, backgrounds
- Initial ideas and explanation of direction you wanted to take
- Important development stages and work showing your art and design skills
- Important design decisions you made during the project
- **Final design**, front cover, spine and back cover
- Details of strengths and areas for further development
