Dear parents/carers,

As a supportive measure, to ensure that students are accessing their learning, we would like to trial some amendments to our current behaviour policy. The changes only apply to Year 11 students as we recognise that their learning in preparation for their exams is our priority.

The following changes will now apply as of Monday 21st November to all Year 11's only.

- If a student receives two C3's in one day, they will have a supervised break and lunch the following day. The student will also receive a detention the next day, where a restorative conversation will be held with the class teacher to ensure that there is a fresh start when the student returns to lesson.
- If a student receives a C3 fail in a lesson, they will be removed for that lesson but will return to class in the next period, if they are in the frame of mind for learning. Students will then lose their break and lunch times the next day. The student will also receive a detention for the following day, where a restorative conversation will be held with the class teacher to ensure that there is a fresh start when the student returns to lesson.
- If a student receives two C3 fails in the same day, then the student will spend the rest of that day and the following day in our Reflections room. The student will also receive a detention for the following day, where a restorative conversation will be held with the class teacher to ensure that there is a fresh start when the student returns to lesson.
- If a student swears directly at a member of staff, they will be removed from that lesson immediately and they will spend a further 5 periods in Reflections.
- If a student walks out of a lesson or truants a lesson, they will receive two days in our Reflections room.
