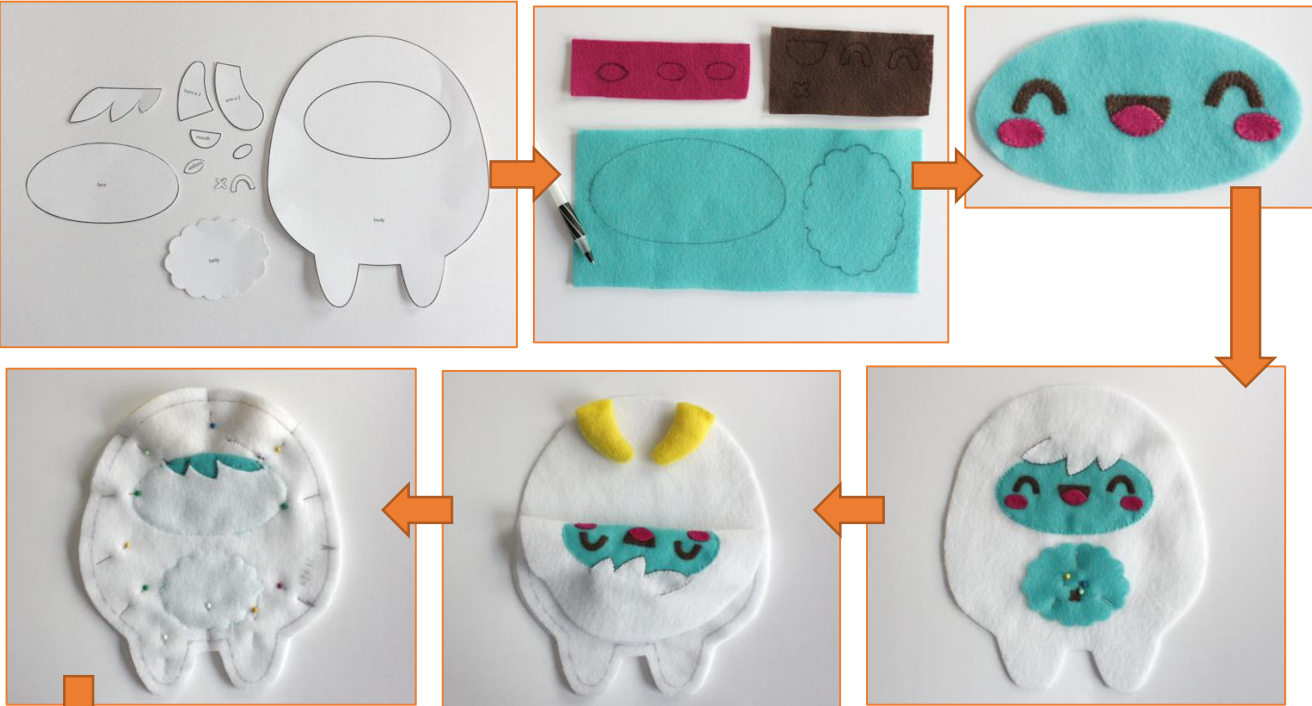




# Felt Monster Tutorial

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<b>STRAIGHT STITCH (SPOKE STITCH)</b> 	<b>SPLIT STITCH</b> 	<b>BUTTONHOLE STITCH</b> 	<b>FRENCH KNOT</b> 
<b>RUNNING STITCH</b> 	<b>CHAIN STITCH</b> 	<b>SPIDER'S WEB</b> 	<b>SATIN STITCH</b> <p>Before working the satin stitch, the area can be outlined with an embroidery stitch to establish an even border. Work the satin stitch inside the outline or outside for a raised effect. When working the satin stitch over a large area, start from the center and work out toward the sides to help keep stitches upright.</p>
<b>BACK STITCH</b> 	<b>FLY STITCH</b> 	<b>CROSS STITCH</b> 	<b>FEATHER STITCH</b> 
<b>OUTLINE STITCH</b> 	<b>LAZY DAISY STITCH</b> 	<b>LONG &amp; SHORT STITCH</b> <p>In the first row, work short and long stitches alternately. In the following rows, all the stitches are long.</p>	<b>HERRINGBONE STITCH</b> 

## Step by step applique

<b>1.</b> 	<p>Choose suitable template and cut out using paper scissors</p> <p>Show skills when cutting, cut to create straight neat edges.</p>	<b>5.</b> 	<p>Remove paper template and put pins back in pot.</p> <p>Check edges of fabric are in proportion and straight.</p>
<b>2.</b> 	<p>Pin your paper template to your chosen base fabric.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pin in wards</li> <li>Enough to hold template in place</li> <li>Pin through both template and fabric</li> </ul>	<b>6.</b> 	<p>Choose a different colour piece of felt, larger than the template</p> <p>Pin fabric template to chosen base fabric.</p> <p>Remember pinning skills from previous steps.</p>
<b>3.</b> 	<p>Ensure pins are placed in the correct way.</p> <p>Place the pins right the way through the template and fabric, securely holding them together.</p>	<b>7.</b> 	<p>Thread needle to prepare for tacking stitch.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Thread needle pulling two ends together</li> <li>Tie a knot at the ends of the thread (not at the top of the needle)</li> </ul>
<b>4.</b> 	<p>Using fabric scissors cut around the template.</p> <p>Show skills when cutting, cut to create straight neat edges.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hold the scissors correctly (thumb in little hole and fingers in the bigger hole)</li> </ul>	<b>8.</b> 	<p>Complete tacking (running stitch) all around template.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Keep tacking stitch to a medium size and neat.</li> <li>When back to the beginning cut thread using thread scissors.</li> </ul>
