Next term we will be adjusting our behaviour policy.

- Students who receive a C3 consequence will receive a same day 30-minute detention.
- Students who receive two C3 consequences in one day will receive a same day 60-minute detention.
- Students who receive a C3 fail will be removed to Reflections and receive a same day 60- minute detention.
- Students who are late after 8:25am will receive a sane day 30-minute detention (extenuating circumstances are considered).
- Students wo are late after 8:55am, when registers close, will receive a same day 60-minute detention (extenuating circumstances are considered).
- Detentions are also given for 'out of lesson incidents' and for 'disrespecting staff'.

As always, reasonable adjustments will be made for those students who require it. All the above will be recorded on the Edulink app so parents are informed. We will endeavour to also inform parents via text message.

The above changes will only ever apply to the few students who do not follow our expectations as the vast majority of our students have good behaviour. We consistently reward our students who display good behaviour.

I thank parents for continuing to support our behaviour policy.
