I am writing to you with information about the GCSE examinations.

Year 11 - GCSE Summer Examinations

All students have a copy of their individual examination timetable. Please contact the office if you would like another copy.

GCSE examinations have begun in Art. MFL speaking exams are next week then the main examination period is Friday 9th May to Monday 16th June inclusive. All students are expected to attend the academy all day, every day, including Period 6 until their last exam on Monday 16th June (there are also some exams on the 17th and 18th June, for a few students). Students will return their Yondr mobile phone pouches at the end of the Physics examination on the 16th June.

Timetables will be adjusted to allow for extra revision before each examination and will be shared daily with students.

Students can attend from 8:00am each day where revision will be in the Zone/Hall.

Parent support
