The Options Booklet:

All students in Year 10 are expected to follow a broad and balanced personalised curriculum that aims to provide the students with the knowledge, understanding and skills to enable them to continue with their studies at Post-16.

Ormiston Maritime Academy will provide students with comprehensive guidance on their options through assembly presentations and individual interviews with students. Most students will base their option choices on a decision based purely on their enjoyment of specific subjects and this is to be encouraged as students who enjoy their courses are more motivated. However, it is also important to ensure that they select a balance of subjects. The options booklet provides further guidance relating to the core subjects that must be studied as part of the curriculum in Year 10 and 11. In addition, there is an outline of the course content and assessment procedures for each of the available option subjects. Please use this information to help you make your choices. Ormiston Maritime Academy will try to ensure that students receive their first choices, but this cannot always be guaranteed.
