Dear Parent/Carer,

Thank you for your continued support over the past five years. As our Year 11 students approach the final few weeks of their secondary education, we would like to take this opportunity to share the arrangements for their remaining time in the academy and to recognise the hard work and commitment they have shown.

As you may be aware, many students have now completed the majority of their GCSE examinations. Therefore, the decision has been made to discontinue the mandatory Period 6. From Monday 8th June 2026, Year 11 students will finish the school day at 3:00pm, in line with the rest of the academy.

#### **Thursday 11th and Friday 12th June**

Students will be sitting some of their final GCSE examinations. Science booster sessions will take place during Periods 3 and 4 on both days to support students in their preparation. Students will then attend lunch as normal and will be dismissed from the academy at 1:20pm. All students will continue to have access to independent revision materials and are encouraged to use their time effectively to prepare for their remaining exams.

#### **Monday 15th June**

This is the final examination day for the majority of students. Students should arrive at the academy at the normal time of 8:20am. The examination will finish at the end of Period 2 (9:40am), after which students will be dismissed from the academy. For most, this will mark the completion of their GCSE examinations.

#### **Tuesday 16th June**

Students studying Spanish will need to attend the academy for their writing examination, arriving at 8:20am as usual. The exam will finish at 9:40am, and students will then be dismissed.

#### **Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> June**

The year 11 Leavers' Assembly will take place on **17th June at 3:00 pm**. Attendance at the assembly is **by invitation only**, and invitations will be communicated via an EduLink message. Students are welcome to dress up or wear their own clothes for the occasion. However, all attire must be appropriate for a school event. Any student whose clothing is considered inappropriate will not be permitted to attend the assembly.



**Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> June**

The Year 11 Prom will be held at the Oaklands Hotel and is open to students who have paid for a ticket.

Students may arrive from **6:50pm**. The prom will conclude at **11:00pm**, and students should arrange to be collected promptly at the end of the evening.
